As you know we received bids for the referenced project at 11:00 A.M. EST April 11, 2016, and three (3) contractors submitted bids. Copies of all bids have been provided under separate cover. The detailed bid results are attached and labeled Exhibit A.

All submitted bids were over budget, but Peavy and Son Construction Co., Inc. was the lowest responsible/ responsive bidder. Therefore, we recommend **awarding the contract to Peavy and Son Construction Co., Inc.** in the amount of **\$526,428.48**. Enclosed is a copy of the Notice of Award and Agreement that need to be executed if the Commission approves our recommendation. Once both documents have been fully executed, a change order will be issued to remove some items from the scope to bring the project within budget.

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the payments and agreements herein after mentioned:
