CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS

JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS Regular Session January 5, 2017

The Board met this date in regular session. Present were Chairman Gene Hall, Commissioners Betsy Barfield, Stephen Fulford, J.T. Surles and Stephen Walker. Also present were County Attorneys Buck Bird and Scott Shirley, County Coordinator Parrish Barwick and Clerk of Court Kirk Reams.

- 1. Chairman Hall led the invocation and pledge of allegiance.
- 2. Commissioner Barfield introduced Andrew Wellman as her District 4 applicant for the Planning Commission.
- 3. On motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Barfield and unanimously carried, the consent agenda—consisting of the approval of the agenda, the minutes of the December 20th, 2016 Regular Session, General/Transportation Fund Vouchers and Mr. Wellman's appointment to the Planning Commission—was approved.
- 4. County Coordinator Parrish Barwick introduced the Committees and Assignments item. Appointments were made with the records of appointments being kept by County Coordinator Barwick. On motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Surles and unanimously carried, the appointments were approved.
- 5. Fire Rescue Chief Mark Matthews presented his recommendations on the fire engine purchasing plan. His revised plan totaled \$512,992, with a \$63,008 savings returned to the General Fund. On motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Barfield and unanimously carried, the recommendation was approved.
- 6. County Coordinator Parrish Barwick and Clerk of Court Kirk Reams introduced the County Health Department funding possibilities item. Among the possibilities mentioned as potential match amounts were reserve funding, sales of surplus property and timber sales. On motion by Commissioner Barfield, seconded by Commissioner Walker and unanimously carried, the Board voted to continue exploring match possibilities for the health department and committed 10% of the total cost per year for the next 2 years.
- 7. Chairman Hall introduced the Planning Commissioner decision item and asked Planning Official Bill Tellefsen to explain the proper process for removing a Planning Commissioner. Mr. Tellefsen stated that the process was outlined in the Land Development Code and was not followed in the instance of the removal of Mr. C.P. Miller. County Coordinator Parrish Barwick stated that it was the Board's prerogative to remove any Planning Commissioner per the LDC rules and that the proper procedures may not have been followed but the authority did exist. Planning Attorney Scott Shirley stated that the Board had the authority but a better practice would be to provide the party in question with notice so that he/she may respond to actions taken. Commissioner Walker stated he did not like the

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way it was handled and that he felt like Mr. Miller was singled out. Commissioner Fulford agreed but stated he did not like to rescind prior Board decisions. Citizen Bud Wheeler stated no one on the Planning Commissioner should be removed for absences except Mr. Miller. Commissioner Barfield stated her desire to have Mr. Tellefsen put together the proper information on attendance records and bring back before the Board. Citizen James Mack stated that the Board should not dismiss someone based on incorrect attendance records. On motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Fulford and carried 4 to 1 (Barfield opposed), the Board rescinded its prior vote to remove Mr. Miller from the Planning Commissioner. On motion by Commissioner Fulford, seconded by Commissioner Walker and unanimously carried, the Board decided to review all attendance records of volunteers on all boards at the first meeting in January every year.

- 8. Clerk of Court Kirk Reams introduced the Main Street request agenda item. Dan Schall, with Main Street, requested that the shelter/carport at the Old Jail and that per their lease with the County, they needed the approval of the Board to move forward. Commissioner Barfield made a motion to approve, to which Commissioner Surles seconded for discussion. Commissioner Fulford stated he would like the Supervisor of Elections input and requested that the County Coordinator reach out to Supervisor of Elections Marty Bishop. Commissioners Barfield and Surles withdrew their motion and second respectively.
- 9. County Attorney Buck Bird was requesting a reverter clause be waived so that the City may retain ownership of the former Humane Society site. Chairman Hall requested this item be placed on the agenda for the next meeting.
- 10. Clerk of Court Kirk Reams gave an update on the historic restoration of the A Building and the Lamont Schoolhouse.
- 11. Commissioner Barfield stated that the surplus property process needed to begin and requested that the item be placed on the next agenda.
- 12. Chairman Hall stated he would like to see the Clerk of Court's recommendation for a workshop on the Fire Assessment and future planning of the Fire Department. He asked if this could be held in March or April.
- 13. Citizen James Mack stated he would like to be on the agenda for the next meeting to discuss concerns for citizens in both District 3 and District 4.
- 14. The warrant register was reviewed and bills ordered paid.
- 15. On motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Fulford and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned.

A RESOLUTION OF THE JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING SPECIAL MAGISTRATE(S) TO CONDUCT CODE ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS RELATED TO VIOLATIONS OF THE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; TERMINATING THE AUTHORITY OF THE CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD; TERMINATING THE CURRENT TERMS OF THE CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD MEMBERS; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Code of Ordinances Sec. 21-1, the code enforcement board and special magistrate(s) are separate authorities for code enforcement hearings and fines, but shall not exercise such powers concurrently.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Code of Ordinances Sec. 21-4, the Board of County Commissioners must, by resolution, specify whether the code enforcement board or special magistrate is authorized to act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF JEFFERSON COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Effective at 12:00 a.m. on March 1, 2017, any special magistrate(s) who are then, or in the future, under contract with the county for code enforcement proceedings are authorized to exercise all authority granted under Code of Ordinances Chapter 21and Chapter 162, Part I, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. Effective at 11:59 p.m. on February 28, 2017, (the day before) the authority of the code enforcement board and the current terms of all members of the code enforcement board are terminated and no further members shall be appointed until such time as the Board of County Commissioners by resolution reauthorizes the code enforcement board to exercise powers.

Section 3. All resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed. This resolution is effective upon adoption and shall remain in effect until amended or repealed.

Draft Form of Agreement Special Magistrate Services

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2017 by and between the Jefferson County, Florida, with principal offices at 1 Courthouse Circle, Monticello, Florida, 32344 hereinafter referred to as "County", and _____, hereinafter referred to as "Special Magistrate".

1. <u>Purpose of Agreement.</u> The purpose of this Agreement is to set forth the continuing terms and conditions under which Special Magistrate shall provide magistrate services to the County.

2. <u>Scope of Services.</u> Special Magistrate agrees to perform and conduct Special Magistrate services for quasi-judicial matters, relating to code enforcement proceedings pursuant to Chapter 162, Part I, Florida Statutes and County Code of Ordinances Chapter 21, and relating to such other matters as the County may, by ordinance, so designate.

3. <u>Compensation.</u> Special Magistrate will be compensated \$250.00 per hearing session. Special Magistrate shall bear his/her own costs and expenses for travel to and from the site of hearings and incidental work outside hearing sessions.

- 4. Throughout the term of this Agreement, Special Magistrate shall;
 - (1) Be an active member in good standing of the Florida Bar.
 - (2) Reside or own property in Jefferson County, Florida.
 - (3) Not be an employee of the County or hold any office with the County government.
 - (4) Comply with the Code of Ethics of the State of Florida.

5. <u>Term.</u> This Agreement contemplates a continuing and ongoing relationship between the County and Special Magistrate. This Agreement shall continue in full force and effect, subject to agreed upon amendments, unless and until terminated upon thirty (30) days' notice by the County Coordinator or Special Magistrate.

6. <u>Billing.</u> Special Magistrate shall provide monthly invoices for services rendered to the County. The County Coordinator shall have statement payment approval authority.

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7. <u>Other Agreements.</u> No prior or present agreements or representations shall be binding upon County or Special Magistrate unless included in this Agreement. No modification or change to this Agreement shall be binding upon the parties unless in writing and executed by the party or parties to be bound thereby.

8. <u>Public Records.</u> ANY QUESTIONS REGARDING THE APPLICATION OF CHAPTER 119, FLORIDA STATUTES, TO SPECIAL MAGISTRATE'S DUTY TO PROVIDE PUBLIC RECORDS RELATING TO THIS CONTRACT SHOULD BE DIRECTED TO THE CUSTODIAN OF PUBLIC RECORDS (CLERK OF COURT) AT (850) 933-3424, (kreames@jeffersonclerk.com), 1 COURTHOUSE CIRCLE, MONTICELLO, FL 32344. (FS § 119.0701) Special Magistrate must comply with the public records laws, Chapter 119, F.S.; specifically Special Magistrate must:

(a) Keep and maintain public records required by the County to perform the service.

(b) Upon request from the County's custodian of public records, provide the County with a copy of the requested records or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time at a cost that does not exceed the cost provided in FS Ch. 119 or as otherwise provided by law.

(c) Ensure that public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements are not disclosed except as authorized by law for the duration of the contract term and following completion of the contract if Special Magistrate does not transfer the records to the County.

(d) Upon completion of the contract, transfer, at no cost to the County, all public records in possession of Special Magistrate or keep and maintain public records required by the County to perform the service. If Special Magistrate transfers all public records to the public agency upon completion of the contract, Special Magistrate shall destroy any duplicate public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements. If Special Magistrate keeps and maintains public records upon completion of the contract, Special Magistrate keeps and maintains public records for retaining the public records. All records stored electronically must be provided to the public agency, upon the request from the public agency's custodian of public records, in a format that is compatible with the information technology systems of the public agency.

9. <u>Assignment.</u> The Special Magistrate shall not enter into any agreements with third parties to delegate any or all of the responsibilities, duties, or rights herein set forth.

10. <u>Independent Contractor</u>. The Special Magistrate shall perform the conditions of this Agreement as an independent contractor and nothing contained herein shall be construed to be inconsistent with this relationship or status. Each hearing attended by Special Magistrate shall be considered a separate and distinct engagement of services hereunder. The Special Magistrate shall be responsible for any and all federal, state and local required deductions and/or taxes on the compensation paid under this agreement and complete and furnish the County with an IRS Form W-9, <u>Request for Taxpayer Identification Number and Certification</u>.

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11. <u>Binding Effects.</u> This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and upon their successors and assigns.

13. <u>Governing Law and Venue</u>. The parties intend that this Agreement and the relationship of the parties shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida. Venue for any action arising out of this Agreement between the parties shall be exclusively in Jefferson County, Florida and nowhere else.

14. <u>JURY TRIAL WAIVER</u>. THE PARTIES TO THE AGREEMENT WAIVE THEIR RIGHTS TO A TRIAL BY JURY REGARDING ANY LAWSUIT INVOLVING THE INTERPETATION, CONSTRUCTION, ENFORCEMENT, OR GOVERNANCE OF THIS AGREEMENT.

SECTION 125.35 – COUNTY SALES OF REAL PROPERTY

125.35 County authorized to sell real and personal property and to lease real property.—

(1)(a) The board of county commissioners is expressly authorized to sell and convey any real or personal property, and to lease real property, belonging to the county, whenever the board determines that it is to the best interest of the county to do so, to the highest and best bidder for the particular use the board deems to be the highest and best, for such length of term and such conditions as the governing body may in its discretion determine.

(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), under terms and conditions negotiated by the board, the board of county commissioners may:

1. Negotiate the lease of an airport or seaport facility;

2. Modify or extend an existing lease of real property for an additional term not to exceed 25 years, where the improved value of the lease has an appraised value in excess of \$20 million; or

3. Lease a professional sports franchise facility financed by revenues received pursuant to s. <u>125.0104</u> or s. <u>212.20</u> which may include commercial development that is ancillary to the sports facility if the ancillary development property is part of or contiguous to the professional sports franchise facility. The board's authority to lease the above described ancillary commercial development in conjunction with a professional sports franchise facility lease applies only if at the time the board leases the ancillary commercial development, the professional sports franchise facility lease to a additional 10 years remaining in the lease term.

(c) No sale of any real property shall be made unless notice thereof is published once a week for at least 2 weeks in some newspaper of general circulation published in the county, calling for bids for the purchase of the real estate so advertised to be sold. In the case of a sale, the bid of the highest bidder complying with the terms and conditions set forth in such notice shall be accepted, unless the board of county commissioners rejects all bids because they are too low. The board of county commissioners may require a deposit to be made or a surety bond to be given, in such form or in such amount as the board determines, with each bid submitted.

(2) When the board of county commissioners finds that a parcel of real property is of insufficient size and shape to be issued a building permit for any type of development to be constructed on the property or when the board of county commissioners finds that the value of a parcel of real property is \$15,000 or less, as determined by a fee appraiser designated by the board or as determined by the county property appraiser, and when, due to the size, shape, location, and value of the parcel, it is determined by the board that the parcel is of use only to one or more adjacent property owners, the board may effect a private sale of the parcel. The board may, after sending notice of its intended action to owners of adjacent property by certified mail, effect a sale and conveyance of the parcel at private sale without receiving bids or publishing notice; however, if, within 10 working days after receiving such mailed notice, two or more owners of adjacent property notify the board of their desire to purchase the parcel, the board shall accept sealed bids for the parcel from such property owners and may convey such parcel to the highest bidder or may reject all offers. (3) As an alternative to subsections (1) and (2), the board of county commissioners may by ordinance prescribe disposition standards and procedures to be used by the county in selling and conveying any real or personal property and in leasing real property owned by the county. The standards and procedures must provide at a minimum for:

(a) Establishment of competition and qualification standards upon which disposition will be determined.

(b) Reasonable public notice of the intent to consider disposition of county property and the availability of copies of the standards. Reasonableness of the notice is to be determined by the efficacy and efficiency of the means of communication used.

(c) Identification of the form and manner by which an interested person may acquire county property.

(d) Types of negotiation procedures applicable to the selection of a person to whom county properties may be disposed.

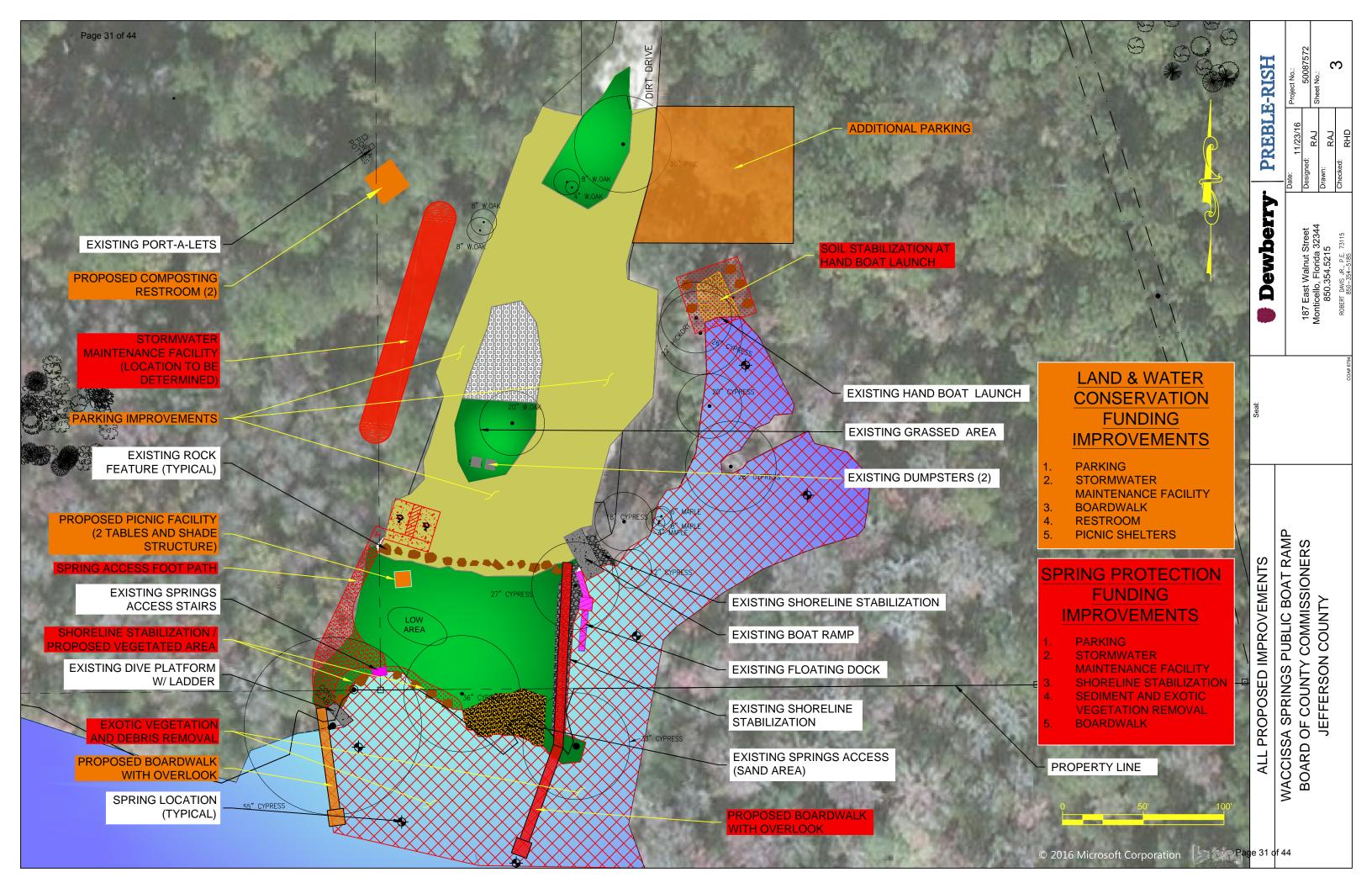
(e) The manner in which interested persons will be notified of the board's intent to consider final action at a regular meeting of the board on the disposition of a property and the time and manner for making objections.

(f) Adherence in the disposition of real property to the governing comprehensive plan and zoning ordinances.

Dear Buck:

At the meeting of the Monticello City Council on December 6, 2016, the Council instructed me to convey its request that Jefferson County execute a quitclaim deed conveying the County's remaining interest in a .87 acre parcel, which is immediately south of the southeast corner of the County Recreation Park on Mamie Scott Drive in Monticello, to the City. The property in question was deeded to the City in 1989, and was then leased by the City to the Jefferson County Humane Society, for use as an animal shelter. Approximately 3 years ago, the Humane Society acquired land in the Wolf Creek subdivision east of Monticello, and abandoned the referenced property.

The property is located immediately west of the City Barn at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. It also borders City property on the west and south sides. The property contains kennels, dog runs and abandoned structures. It is currently being used to store City vehicles.

The reason for the City Council's request is the language of the enclosed 1989 deed from the County to the City, which includes language, at the end of the legal description, wherein the County "reserves an automatic right of reversion of this land and any improvements thereon, should the Jefferson County Humane Society discontinue use as an animal shelter." Pursuant to our discussion, it appears that a quitclaim deed would resolve the issue and confirm the City's ownership of the parcel. Page 34 of 44 T. Buckingham Bird, Esq. December 9, 2016 Page 2

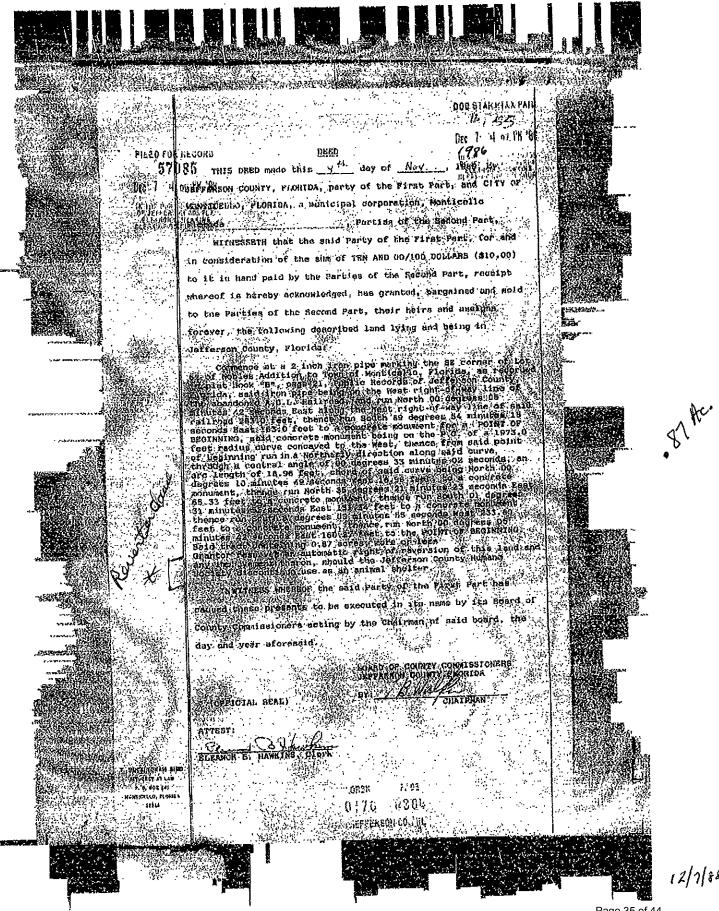

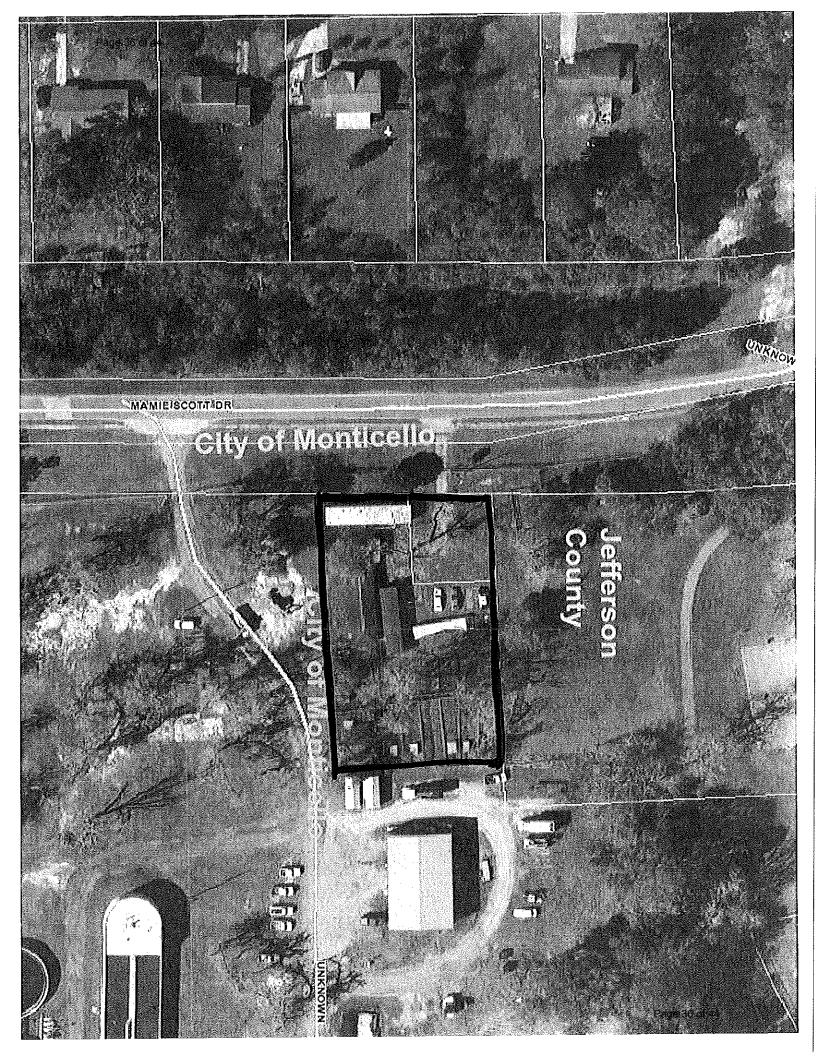

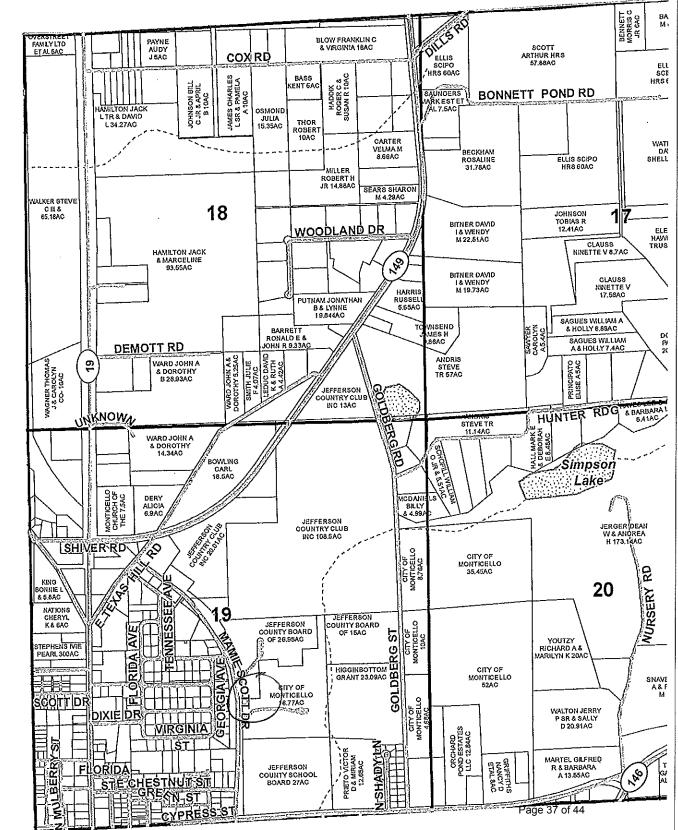
